These questions are provided to assist in preparing for Inquiry submission through our upcoming online portal, which will launch the first week of December.

Project Details

Project Title: Provide a descriptive yet concise name for the project. We suggest no more than 8 words. We'll use this name in future correspondence with you to identify the project.

Project Start Date: Please indicate the desired funding start date. This date should not be earlier than the Inquiry deadline. (See Granting Timelines at damascusroadfoundation.ca/apply for deadlines and expected disbursement dates for approved projects.)

Project End Date: Please indicate the end of the period this Inquiry covers. This should be no more than three years from the start date (1 year for first-time applicants.) See Grant Length at damascusroadfoundation.ca/apply for more information.

Implementation Location: Please select the country or countries where the project will be implemented.

Implementation Location Notes: You may use this textbox to indicate specific regions, states/provinces, or cities where you will be working. Maximum Length: 150 characters.

Project Contact: Enter the name, title and email of the primary person Damascus Road Foundation should contact with respect to this project. It may be the same or different from Organization contacts provided in your Profile earlier.

Project Budget

Overall Budget (By year, if appropriate): Include all anticipated project costs, including those covered by other sources, as well as any indirect overhead or management expenses.

Grant Request (By year, if appropriate): Indicate the specific amount requested from the Damascus Road Foundation. Please also see Preferred Areas of Funding at damascusroadfoundation.ca/apply.

Budget Summary: Please describe the major expenditure line items in your budget to help us understand how the funding is expected to be used.
